

Notes for Contributors

1. Contributions and books for review should be sent to the editor: Dr Arvind Sharma, Department of Religious Studies, The University of Sydney, New South Wales, 2006, Australia
2. Contributions should be in English and should be typewritten (double spaced on A4 paper), with a seven space indent for paragraphs.
3. All footnotes should be consecutively numbered and appear at the end of the article, also in double space.
4. Referencing Style should conform as far as possible to the following pattern:

Books:

Eric J. Sharpe, Comparative Religion: A History (London: Duckworth, 1975).

Chapters from Books:

Clifford Geertz, "Religion as a Cultural System", in Michael Banton (ed.), Anthropological Approaches to the Study of Religion (London: Tavistock Publications, 1968).

Journal Articles:

Helen E. Payne, "The Integration of Music and Belief in Australian Aboriginal Culture", Religious Traditions 1(1):8-18.

5. Contributors should keep a copy themselves for use when correcting proofs.
6. Each article-length manuscript should contain a brief abstract of 50 to 75 words on a separate sheet.
7. Submission of an article is taken to imply that it has not previously been published, or is not being considered for publication elsewhere. If manuscripts are to be returned, stamps or international coupons should be sent to cover postage.
