JASAL welcomes essays that consider Australian literature in all its forms (fictional, critical, print, filmic, and so on) and in terms of its socio-political and cultural contexts. We encourage comparative studies with other literatures and are particularly interested in contributions that challenge received critical paradigms and contribute to public debate. JASAL also welcomes review articles (up to 4000 words) and responses to previously published material (up to 2000 words).

Contributors should submit both three hard copies and an email (or disk) copy of manuscripts to the editors. Essay manuscripts must be no longer than 6000 words (excluding Works Cited and Endnotes), double-spaced and documented using MLA style. This style is précised in the JASAL Style Guide, available in print form in each volume of the journal and online at http://www.asc.uq.edu.au/asal. Manuscripts that do not comply with the Style Guide may be rejected by the editors. Authors are responsible for obtaining copyright permission for any illustrations or figures cited in their texts. Manuscripts are refereed anonymously and should be identified using a separate covering letter. Allow 3 months for consideration.
